ECCC WORSHIP GUIDELINES

A. Worship is to reflect the callings of the Group.

ECCC is being called to be the Body of Christ, to make disciples of Christ and worshipers of God. We will worship in spirit and in truth under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

ECCC also is being called to bear testimony for Christ Jesus Christ and his virtues will be modeled for our spiritual growth and in worship.

ECCC is specifically focused on equipping saints with the knowledge of God and the Word of God.

Our worship should reflect above characteristics of callings, as being Holy Spirit guided, Christ modeled and in-depth understand of the need of God from his worshipers.

B. Worship is to respond to God's desires with the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

In order to maintain the order for Sunday worship services, we choose a Key/Lead Worshiper* to guide worshipers into the communion with God.

Key/Lead Worshipers are selected from brothers and sisters who have the desire *to* worship our Lord and willing to increase in spiritual maturity, testimony, and understanding of the need of God and his people.

C. Expectations

Prior to Worship: Prepare self daily to be an acceptable vessel for the Lord.

During Worship: Maintain the peace and readiness from the worshipers. Be responsive to the Holy Spirit and the circumstance of the worship. Bring in worshiper's spirits into the presence of the Lord.

Need not to design or plan in advance any specific ways to help the worshiper, but be sensitive to the spiritual conditions of the people. Avoid interruption, soulish actions, stimulation, and manipulation with performance methods, unusual movements, and group-dynamics techniques.

After Worship: Review the worship service conditions with fellow Key/Lead Worshipers, or with Planning Group for future improvement in our worship services.
